There has been a significant change in the bus service through the village. There are now no direct buses to Waterbeach/Ely between 07:51 and 17:15. If people want to travel to these places then they need to get a bus to Milton and change there.

The parish council understands that this has affected some residents of the village and as such is willing to look in to alternative options to help them.

In order to provide a suitable solution to this, the parish council need to understand how many people this change has directly affected.

Please can you let the parish council know if you are affected or know of anyone who is? Additionally we would need details of when/how often (etc.) people would want to use the bus.
