Landbeach Parish Council wishes to fill a vacancy of Parish Councillor by co-option. If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor, please contact The Clerk for details of what is involved and how to apply; the closing date for applications is 12 noon on **4 June 2018**.

To qualify, a person must, on the day of election, be a British subject or citizen of the EU or Ireland and have attained the age of 18 years. Also

- a) on that day is and therefore continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority, or
- b) has during the whole 12 months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the area, or
- c) has their principal or only place of work during that twelve months in the area, or
- d) has during the twelve months resided in that area, or
- e) during the whole twelve months has resided in the parish or within 4.8 kilometres (three miles) of it.

Disqualification from being elected a member is set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.

ALL SAINTS' CHURCH IMPROVEMENTS

All Saints' Church is applying for a Faculty (the legal permission to carry out any alterations) for internal and external repairs to the walls at the west end of the north aisle to address damp in the fabric, and to install an island-type servery unit at the west end of the north aisle.

As part of this programme to enlarge and enhance the community facilities we intend to remove 5 of the 7 free-standing pews located at the west end of the church. Three of these are 16th century, originally from Jesus College Chapel, and two are Victorian. The remaining two will be retained as part of the final furnishing arrangement.

The church is holding a **Garden Party on Saturday 14 July** from 2.30 to 5 pm, with stalls, games, exhibitions and refreshments. We will also make this a **Gift Day**, and invite parishioners to make a donation towards the funds needed to pay for the works proposed.
