HERBERT JOHN, "JACK", HATTON

Private 42805, 12th Battalion, Durham Light Infantry

Killed in action 15 July 1918, aged 27

Born Milton; enlisted Cambridge

Son of John and Harriet Hatton of Milton;

husband of Kate Hatton, 3 Gentles Yard, Northampton St, Cambridge

Buried in BARENTHAL MILITARY CEMETERY, ITALY

"Jack" Hatton, who died a century ago this month, was the older brother of Harry J Hatton who died in September 1914. Thanks to Jack's grandson Colin for supplying biographical detail - here's a little of it.

Jack lived a large part of his short life in Landbeach, first with his parents, and then with his wife and their two sons, until being mobilised in April 1916. Jack had an impressive war record on the Western Front, being wounded twice before his regiment was transferred to the mountains of N. Italy to fight the Austrians. Sadly, Jack's luck ran out when he was killed, during fierce fighting, by a shell landing on his trench.

A message from our new Community Warden

Hello, I am Mary, the new Community Warden for Waterbeach, Landbeach and Chittering.

I have been in post since mid-April and have started to work with a small group of people within the villages. The Community Warden Scheme is provided through Age UK Cambridgeshire and Peterborough and helps people over 60 years to remain living at home as independent and safely as possible. As a Warden I will make daily contact, Mon to Fri either by a phone call or a visit. Some of the things I can help you with are shopping, prescription collection, making phone calls on your behalf, help to complete forms, liaise with other services, arrange home safety checks etc. I can help with finding a home support, Handyperson or Gardener, or how to order meals on wheels. Most of my time is spent talking through daily topics, old memories, good and bad and providing a listening ear. There is a small weekly charge for this service.

I would like to thank the Parish Councils Group who researched all the working models possible and obtained funding for the scheme to be in place.
