Fen Edge Archaeology Group Talk - Wed 03 OCT - 19.30 (doors open 19:15) Landbeach Village Hall, "The Relhan collection: recording south Cambridgeshire's antiquities in the early 19th century", Alison Taylor. *Richard Relhan, early C19 Cambridge apothecary, travelled around south Cambridgeshire in a horse and cart, making water colour record drawings of attractive sites and buildings in many villages. There are over 300 of these drawings, many illustrating church monuments and scenes of topographic interest. Unusual items include Barnwell Priory and the Cellarers' Chequer, Anglesey Abbey and Bartlow Hills. As the drawings were made before Victorian repairs etc were made to churches, and when memorials were still comparatively fresh, the drawings are a valuable historic record. They now belong to Cambridge Antiquarian Society. The University Library has digitised the drawings on behalf of the Society, whose members will prepare notes on many of the monuments recorded, and all will be made publicly available.*

Bus News

Stagecoach have changed the bus timetables slightly from 3rd Sept.

It appears that the cost of a return ticket from Landbeach to Cambridge is £7.20. That is ridiculous. You can save 20p (wow!) by buying a Cambridgeshire Dayrider Plus, conveniently entitling you to travel to Cambridge via Peterborough or Saffron Walden. If, on the other hand, you lived in Horningsea or Milton, you would only have to buy a Cambridge Dayrider for “just” £4.50.

County Councillor Anna Bradnam is trying to help us, but it seems clear to me that Stagecoach are struggling to make any sort of profit on these routes and that we need public subsidies if we are to have a decent bus service. A use for the “Brexit dividend”, perhaps (if it ever materialises)!
