
What's On In Landbeach - October 2018

At the weekend I saw THREE white egrets standing in the Waterbeach Rd field - looking rather miserable, it must be said!

Friends of Worts Meadow Pond Update

As the lyrics say: "If you go down to the woods today, you're sure of a big surprise" - but hopefully it will be a good one.

Froglife (the national charity for the conservation of amphibians and reptiles) has constructed us a new pond adjacent to the other two small ponds between Worts Meadow and Bourne Wood. The area had become completely overgrown by scrub, which has now been cleared. The other two ponds, both of which dried out this summer, are also being renovated.

The aim is to make a better and more attractive habitat for our **Great Crested Newts** as well as other amphibians and waterlife. It will look pretty messy for a few months but will quickly recover and the newts will undoubtedly be back in the ponds next year in early spring. Ultimately the area should provide all of us with a place to watch and enjoy our local wildlife as well as helping to conserve ever dwindling populations of amphibians.
