## **Q & A - Waterbeach New Town Park and Ride bus**

*What's On submitted the following questions to the Transport Assessment Team at Cambridgeshire County Council. Here are their answers - thank you very much to the team for their help.*

*Do come along to the Annual Parish Meeting on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April to learn more.*

*Q. What route will the P&R buses take through Landbeach?*

A. The buses are planned to avoid the A10 and the applicant proposes that the route is via Green End, High Street and Landbeach Road.

*Q. Will they stop in Landbeach?*

A. Yes this should be possible

*Q. Where will the bus stops in Landbeach be?*

A. The assumption is that buses would use the bus stops in both directions at the junction of Waterbeach Road and Cockfen Lane, and some improvements are planned at these bus stops for passengers waiting for a bus.

*Q. Will it be permitted for people in Landbeach to use the buses to get to/from Cambridge/Waterbeach New Town, even though they have not parked at the P&R car park?*

A. Yes the bus service would benefit the residents of Landbeach in this way, and will result in a much improved bus service to these destinations.

*Q. What will be the frequency of the buses? Will they start less frequently and then become more frequent as more houses are built?*

A. Yes at the beginning the service would be every 30 minutes, and at the time of around 900 dwellings the bus service would be every 10 minutes.

*Q. When are these buses likely to start running (e.g. 2020? 2025?)*

A. The bus service is linked to the construction of the first houses, so when the first house is built on the old Barracks site the bus service will begin.

*Q. At the Waterbeach end, will the P&R site connect easily with the facilities available in the New Town?*

A. Yes there will be an initial P&R car park, and in the future the bus will route to the town centre.

*Q. Are there any likely planning objections or anything else that could prevent the buses from stopping in Landbeach?*

A. Not that I am aware of at present.
