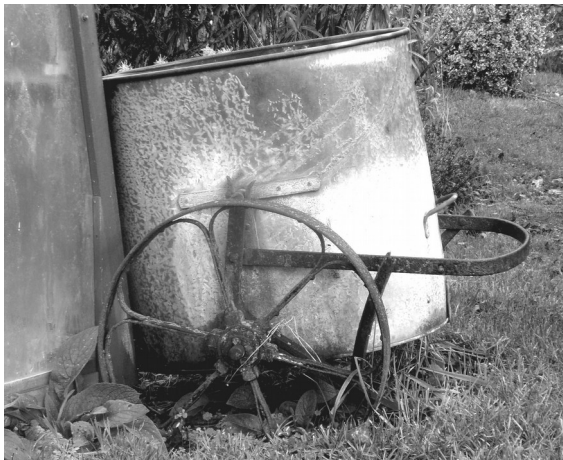
Very different now! Landbeach is part of "Greater Cambridge" whether we like it or not. Please do join in their consultations.
